Preschool education at Darlington Children's Centre

In South Australia, preschools are also known as kindergartens.

If your child turns four before 1 May, they can start preschool on the first day of term one in that year. If your child turns four on or after 1 May, they can start preschool on the first day of term one the following year.

Children can access up to four terms of preschool before they start school.

Aboriginal children and children under guardianship of the Minister are entitled to attend preschool once they turn three.

Children with additional needs and/or disability may be able to start preschool up to two terms before they would usually start.

At the Darlington Children's Centre preschool, children learn through play-based programs that are designed and delivered by qualified teachers.
