Monday + Tuesday 8:30-3:15 and alternate Friday 12:15-3:13

OR

Wednesday + Thursday 8:30-3:15 and alternate Friday 8:30-11:30

Kindergarten provides 15 hours of universal access to preschool for children 4 years of age in the year before they start school. Kindergarten programs are play-based educational programs

designed and delivered by qualified teachers using the national curriculum framework.

If your child turns 4 before 1 May, you can register your child to start Kindergarten in term 1
If your child turns 4 between 1 May to 31 October, you can register your child with us to start

Occasional Care

For 2 years and older

Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday: 8.45am—11.30am

Thursday only: 12:15pm-3:00pm

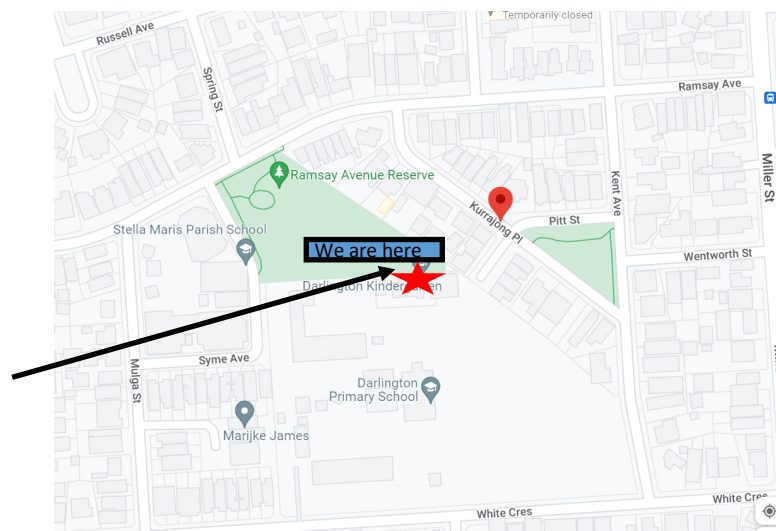
For under and Over 2 years old

Occasional Care is short term child care for toddlers and children under 4 years who do not access Child care or other care services.. Care is available for up to one session per week, depending on availability. Bookings are required.

Enter through Ross Street to access the building but you can find a park on Pitt Street or Kurrajong Place. Look for the signs about where you can park your car.

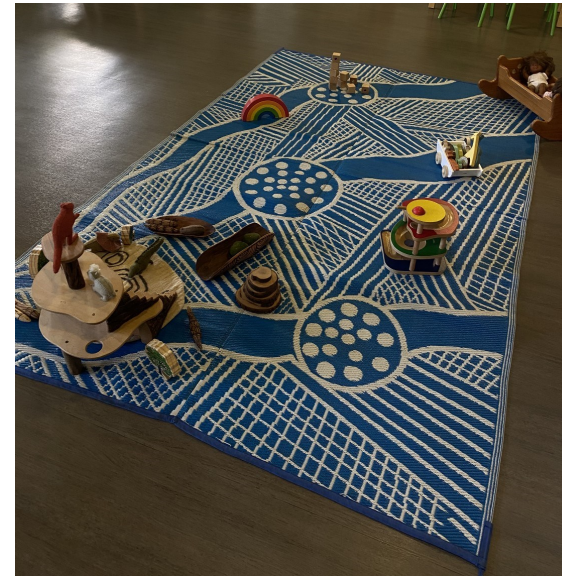
