## Kindergarten

Group A	Monday and Tuesday 8:30-3:15 and alternate Friday afternoon 12:15-3:15
Group B	Wednesday and Thursday 8:30-3:15 and alternate Friday morning 8:30-11:30

Kindergarten provides 15 hours of universal access to preschool for children 4 years of age in the year before they start school. Kindergarten programs are play-based educational programs designed and delivered by qualified teachers using the National Curriculum Framework EYLF.

**If your child turns 4 before 1 May**, you can register your child to start Kindergarten in term 1  
**If your child turns 4 between 1 May to 31 October**, you can register your child with us to start preschool in the mid year intake in term 3

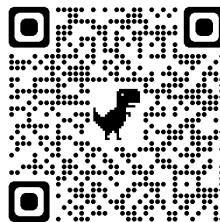
