Group A	Monday and Tuesday 8:30-3:15 and alternate Friday afternoon 12:15-3:15 Mid year children start
Group B	Wednesday and Thursday 8:30-3:15 and alternate Friday morning 8:30-11:30- January children start

Kindergarten provides 15 hours of universal access to preschool for children 4 years of age in the year before they start school. If your child turns 4 before 1 May, you can register your child to start Kindergarten in term 1. If your child turns 4 between 1 May to 31 October, you can register your child with us to start preschool in the mid year intake in term 3.

Occasional Care

is short term child care for toddlers and children under 4 years who do not access Child care or other care services.. Care is available for up to one session per week, depending on availability. Bookings are required.

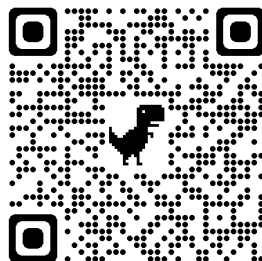
